

### Let's remember WHY IYCF-

E?

- In emergencies, children are vulnerable to malnutrition, illness and death;
  child deaths can be two to seventy times higher than the average rate.
- Lack of breastfeeding support and inappropriate distributions of BMS are challenges resulting in increased infant morbidity and mortality


 Protection, promotion, and support of safe and appropriate feeding for infants and young children in all types of emergencies, with the goal of safeguarding their survival, health and growth.


#### Supporting the nutritional needs of:


- Infants and young children from birth to two year of age

- Well-being of mothers


























