

Since January 2021 The Alliance website has had:


- 7383 Unique Users












Where are requests coming from?

Webinars:

- 2 webinar took place: "A Learning and Sharing Café: WHO/UNICEF IYCF Indicators: challenges and opportunities in humanitarian contexts" and "Learning and Sharing Café: Preventing and managing inappropriate donations Breastmilk substitutes and other prohibited products"
- These were attended by 348 participants, 170 (49%) where from local NGOs

Learning Needs & Products

 Work continues on a learning brief and podcast regarding local NGOs using the Alliance to support their technical capacity gaps and needs; a learning piece on use of MUAC and WHZ classification, and Yemen NIS Taskforce evaluation

Thought Leadership Updates



- The IFE Core Group held its annual meeting remotely and attended by 37 members.
- Within the Wasting GTWG, a consultant was recruited to conduct a mapping of national policies and updates to national guidelines. A draft background document on Balanced Energy & Protein (BEP) supplementation in pregnancy has been reviewed by the wider GTWG.
- Within the NIS GTWG, a revised version of guidance for the implementation of nutrition assessments in Northern Ethiopia was presented to the Ethiopia Taskforce and an inaugural meeting for the Predictive Analytics Taskforce was held.
- The CVA and Nutrition GTWG began work on a mapping of initiatives and survey of gaps, led by a team of consultants.
- A fourth cross-chair quarterly call was set up to explore areas of collaboration across the GTWGs and processes for identifying technical gaps.
- The Nutrition Guidance in Ebola Treatment Units Taskforce held two meetings in the quarter.



The Alliance's Work to date


- From April 2020 December 2021 the Alliance has:
