

# OVERVIEW OF **COUNTRY LEVEL TRENDS**

- Total of 34 countries reported on cluster/sector coordination for January-June 2022
- 76.9M identified as people in need (PIN) of nutrition interventions in 2022 (an increase of 12.3M from the 2021 Mid-year report)
- 51% of people targeted (25M of 49.3M) were reached through NiE response by mid-2022
- 30% of funding received (USD 804M) from total amount requested (USD 2,723M) - 7% more compared to the 2021 Mid-year report

# CHALLENGES AT COUNTRY LEVEL

- The occurrence of natural disasters (earthquake, floods) has a serious impact on the already fragile populations which are in dire humanitarian need, such disasters led to strain on available resources.
- Insufficient funding for nutrition interventions.
- The impact of the Ukraine crisis, namely the impact on the implementation level of planned interventions due to the increase in the prices of different inputs and the reduction of funding to NGOs involved in different nutrition in emergency responses (due to funding diversion to Ukraine).
- Staffing gaps at the national and sub-national levels.
- Limited funding for essential nutrition commodities needed for management of wasting (ex. RUSF, RUTF).
- More deterioration of the underlying causes of malnutrition such as access to health services, upsurge of communicable diseases, poor water and sanitation conditions, food insecurity situation, instability and population movement.


