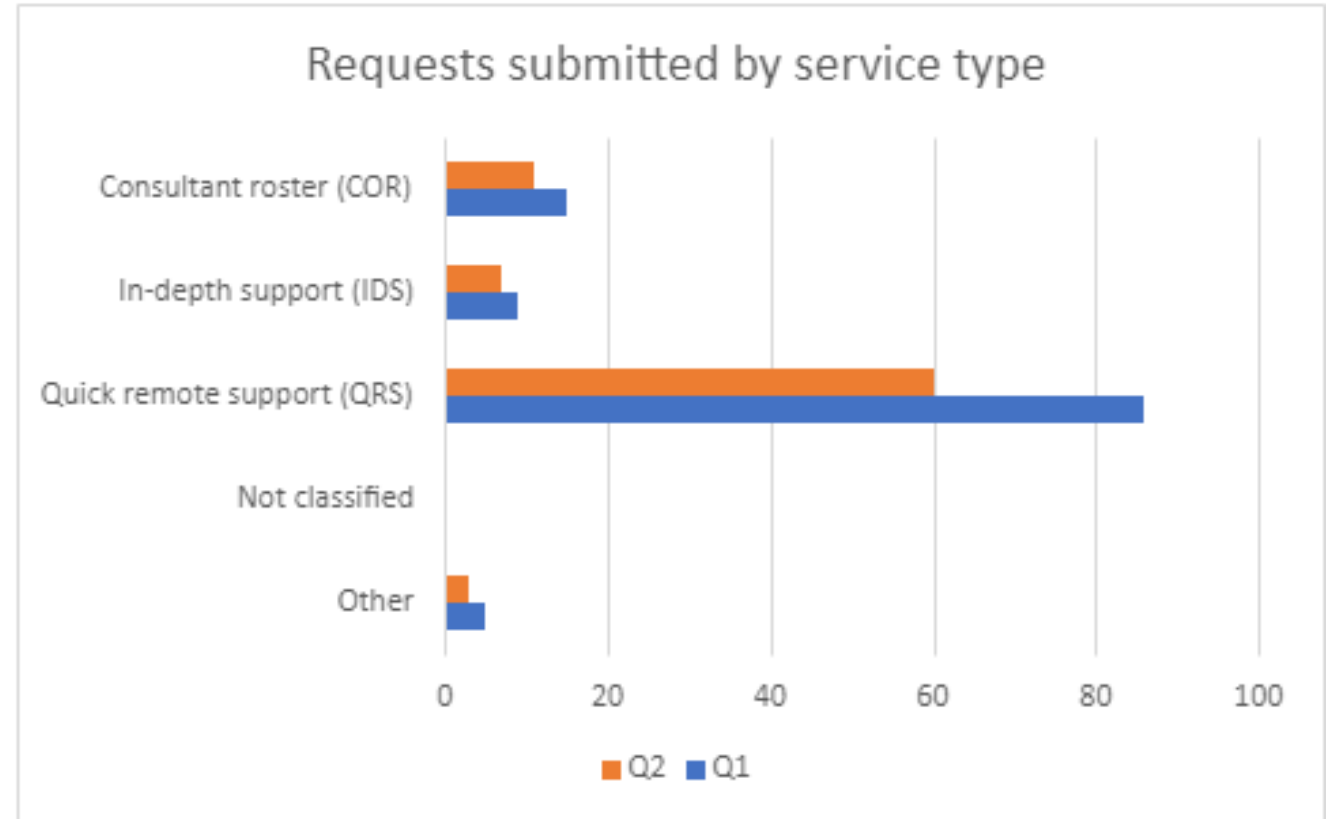

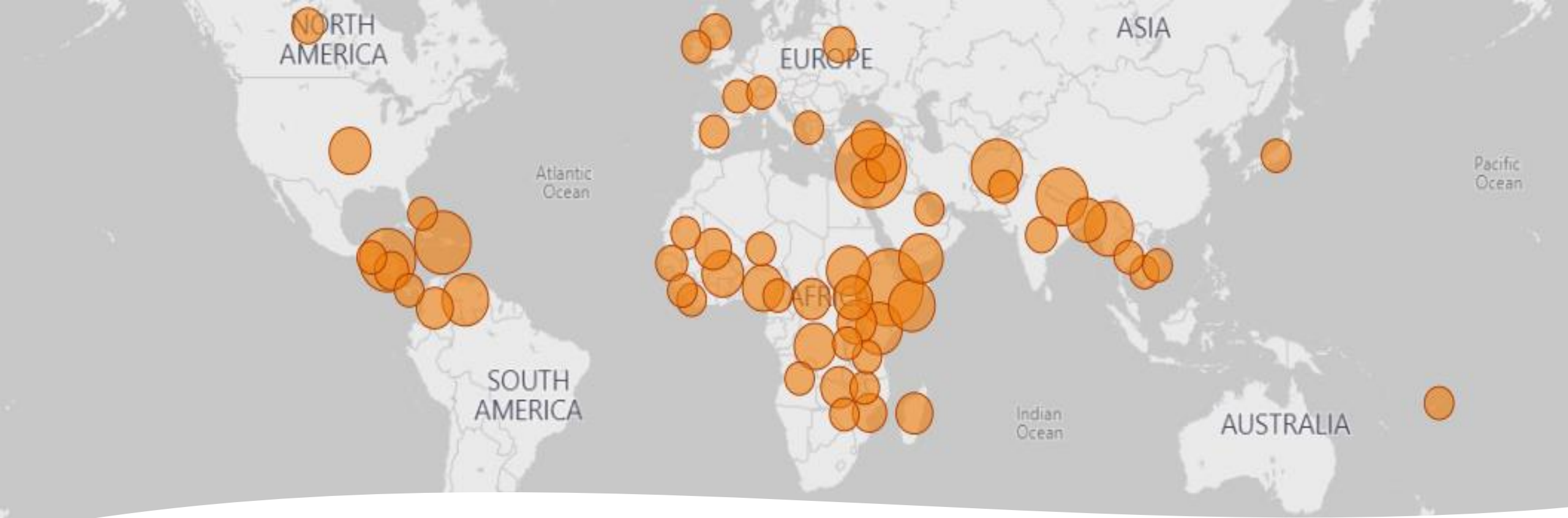

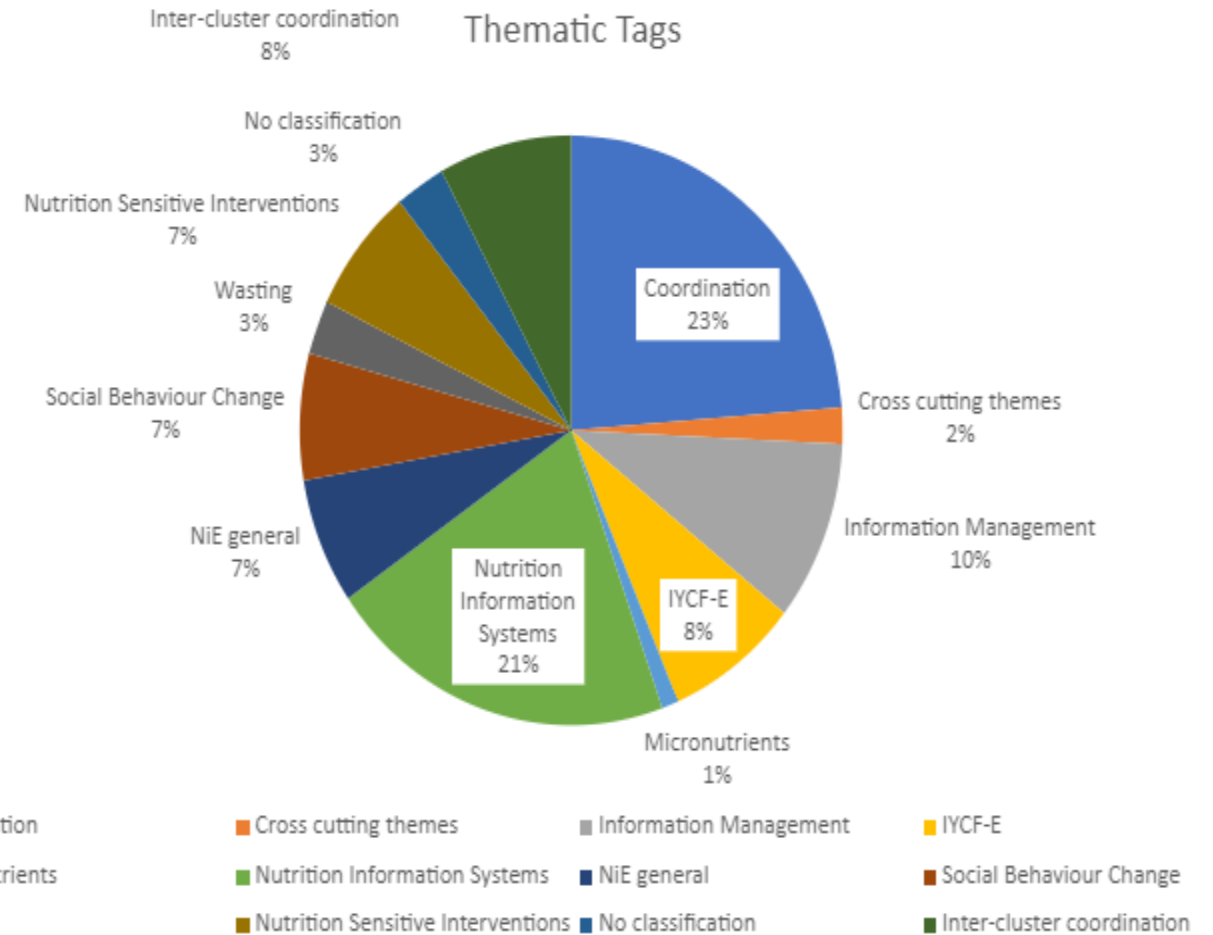
## The Alliance's Work to date

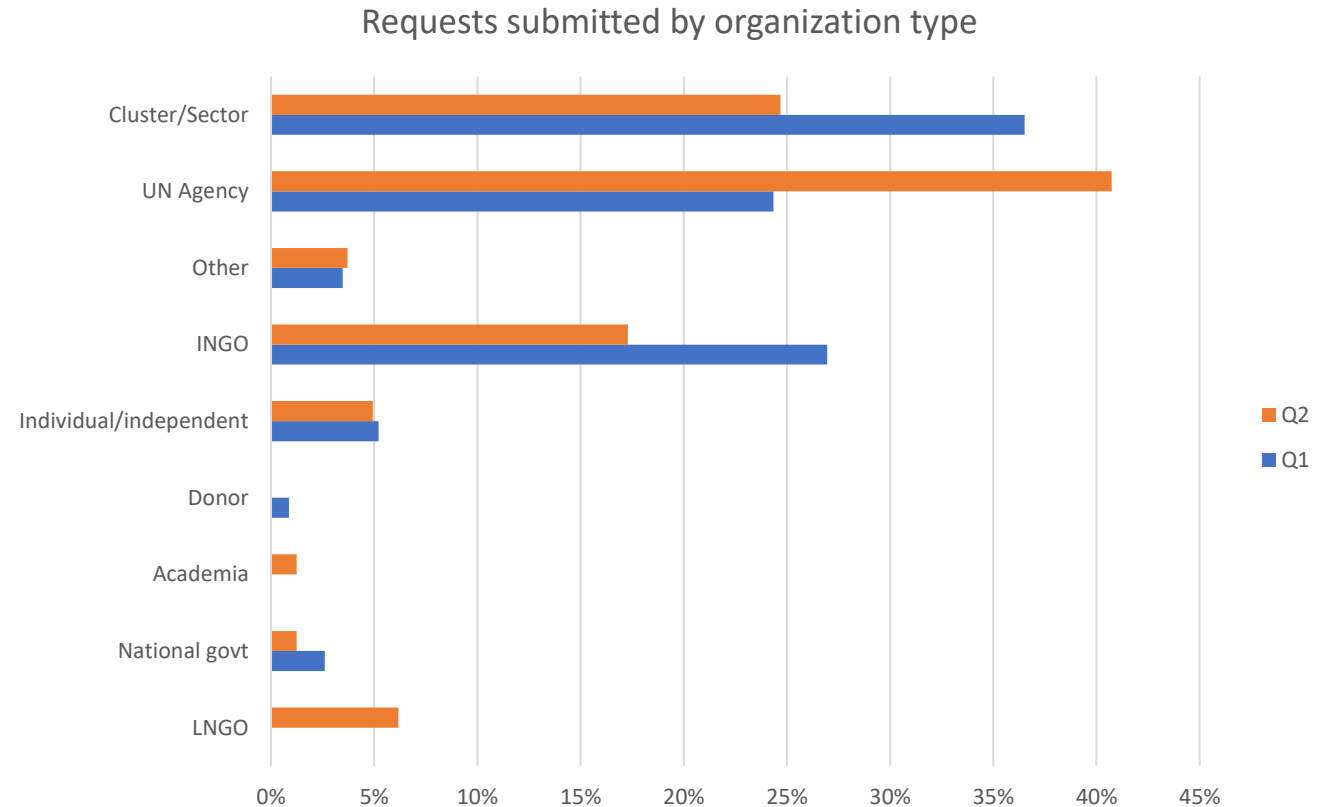
# Who is requesting support?

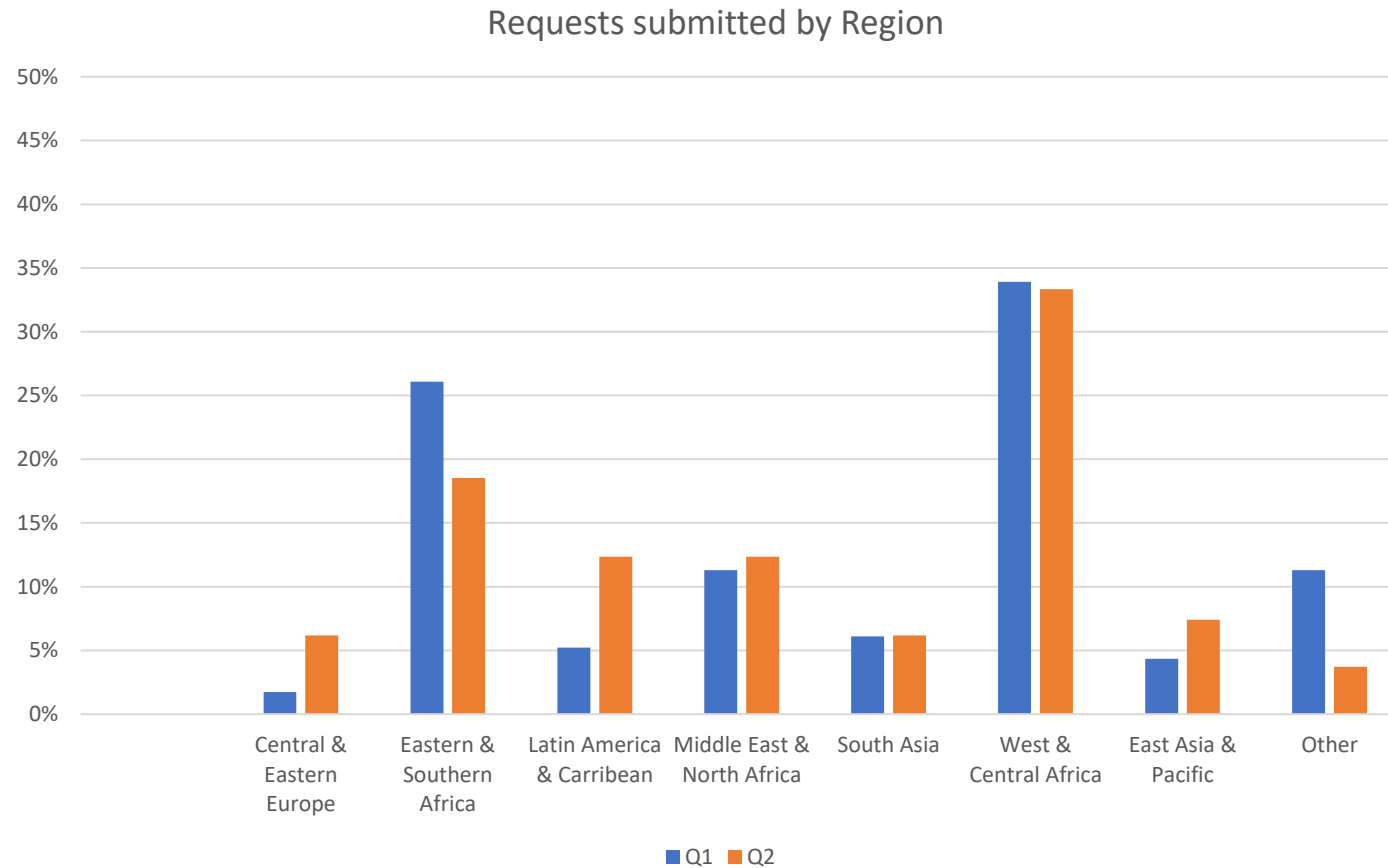

# Cross-cutting themes workstreams

There are 6 established workstreams looking at cross-cutting themes

- Anti-racism and Localization (A&L); Gender & GBV; Disability; Humanitarian Development Nexus (HDN); Accountability to affected populations (AAP) and Climate Change

## **Some key achievement this quarter include:**

- *Gender and GBV*: First gender and nutrition in-country support provided in Ethiopia with the Emergency Nutrition Coordination Unit.
- *AAP*: Discussion on workplan activities; initiated work on FAQ for AAP in nutrition
- *A&L*: Proposed definition of LNA for TST. Hosted TST chat on Ramadan.
- *HDPN*: Brainstorming on topics for HDPN FAQ document, presentation of N4D work in Yemen.
- *Disability*: This quarter focused on information sharing and brainstorming on how to reach new members.
- *Climate Change*: Discussion on the different areas of work for the workstream (preparedness/resilience, food systems and nutrition, environmental justice, environmental impact), a decision was taken to focus on preparedness/resilience and environmental impact for the coming months



# Webinars & Knowledge Management

## Webinars:

- One webinar was held this quarter with the CVA GTWG *Introductory Concepts/Orientation on Cash Voucher Assistance Programming in Nutrition in Emergencies and Exploring opportunities for adoption in Myanmar.*
- 65 participants attended, 48% were from local NGOs or national governments.

# Thought Leadership Updates

- 5 Global thematic working groups with 217 members ran in Q1 – IFE core group, Wasting GTWG, NiS GTWG, CVA GTWG, and MAMI GTWG, along with 2 Taskforces: Maternal Nutrition and Ebola
- The following guidance was finalized this quarter:

- Four requests were escalated to the CVA GTWGs for support
  - Three were requests to the CVA GTWG for support in TOR development for Ops Guidance on CVA
  - CVA support to for a webinar on CVA for Myanmar
